A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act incorporating the Town of McIntyre, 28
2 Georgia, approved March 30, 1971 (Ga. Laws 1971, p. 2370), 29
3 so as to change the date of the municipal elections; to 30
4 provide for terms; to provide an effective date; to repeal 31
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes. 32

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 34

7 Section 1. An Act incorporating the Town of 37
8 McIntyre, Georgia, approved March 30, 1971 (Ga. Laws 1971, 38
9 p. 2370), is hereby amended by striking in its entirety the 39
10 first sentence of the first paragraph of Section 4-15, which 40
11 reads as follows: 41

12 "An election shall be held on the first Saturday in 42
13 October, 1971, for the purpose of electing five 43
14 aldermen.", 44
15 and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 46

16 "An election shall be held on the second Saturday 47
17 in December, 1981, and biennially thereafter, for the 48
18 purpose of electing a mayor and five aldermen.", 49
19 and by striking from the second sentence thereof the 50
20 following: 51

21 "on the first Saturday in October", 53
22 and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 55
23 "on the second Saturday in December", 57
24 and by striking in its entirety the last sentence thereof, 58
25 which reads as follows: 59

26 "The mayor and aldermen first elected shall take 60
27 office on January 1, 1972.", 61

1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following: 63

2 "The mayor and aldermen shall take office on the 64

3 first day of January immediately following their 65

4 election and shall serve for terms of two years and 66

5 until their successors are elected and qualified.", 67

6 so that when so amended said first paragraph of Section 4-15 68

7 shall read as follows: 69

8 "An election shall be held on the second Saturday 71

9 in December, 1981, and biennially thereafter, for the 72

10 purpose of electing a mayor and five aldermen. Every 73

11 person desiring to become a candidate for either the 74

12 office of mayor or for the office of aldermen of the 75

13 said Town of McIntyre shall file or cause to be filed 76

14 with the clerk of the Town of McIntyre, not later than 77

15 20 days before the general election, which election 78

16 shall be held on the second Saturday in December, 79

17 biennially, a statement of his or her candidacy, 80

18 reciting that he is offering for mayor or as alderman. 81

19 The candidate shall further file with the clerk of the 82

20 Town of McIntyre a certificate sworn to, by him, that he 83

21 is qualified to fill the office to which he seeks 84

22 election. All candidates for the office of mayor or for 85

23 the office of alderman shall be elected by the voters of 86

24 the town at large, and a candidate for mayor must attain 87

25 a majority of the votes cast in any election to be 88

26 elected. In instances where no candidate receives a 89

27 majority of the votes cast, a runoff election shall be 90

28 held, between the two candidates receiving the highest

29 number of votes, on the fourteenth day after the day of

30 holding the first election. The candidate receiving a

31 majority of the votes cast in such runoff election shall

32 be declared the winner. The five candidates for the

33 office of aldermen receiving the highest number of votes

34 shall be elected as aldermen. The mayor and aldermen

1 shall take office on the first day of January 91
 2 immediately following their election and shall serve for
 3 terms of two years and until their successors are 92
 4 elected and qualified." 93

5 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on 95
 6 January 1, 1981. 96

7 Section 3. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 98
 8 with this Act are hereby repealed. 99
