The City of McIntyre called council meeting was held on September 26, 2022 with Mayor Vicki Horne presiding. Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Rico Myrick, Katherine Scott, John Carswell, and Debra Kennedy.



Mayor Horne stated, before he gets started, she would like Attorney David to look over the information. Attorney David asked City Clerk Davonia to send the information to him on Tuesday.
